In 2021, the number of doctors participating in our training grew by 40% from 2020 and the number of FEMM teachers certified grew as well. FEMM welcomed 100 new medical providers– including nurses, nurse practitioners, and medical students, a majority of whom are in the OBGYN field. FEMM welcomed 258 new teachers in 2021.
